Be under no illusions though - it can be a hard slog trying to gain your first client, but if you keep your standards high and never stop promoting your business you can go far!

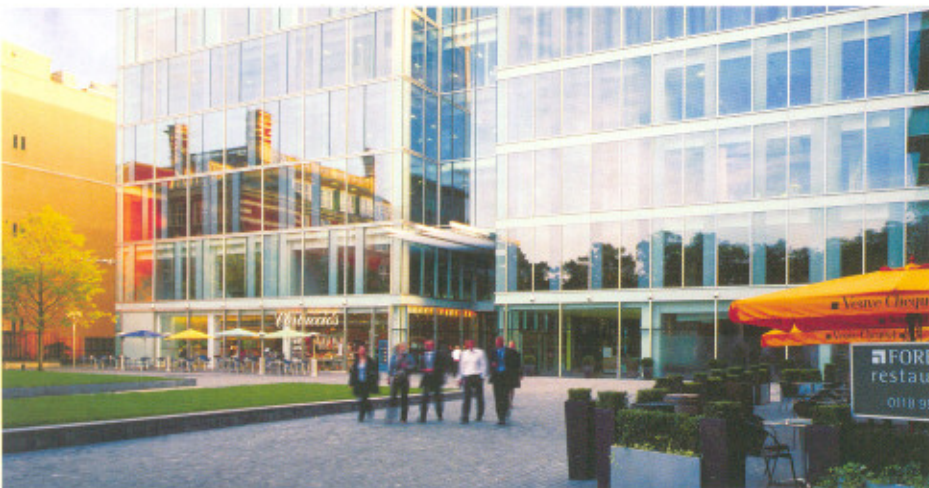

Expro Fuels Growth At Davidson House

Stonemartin Corporate Centres is proud to announce the signing of yet another big client, Expro International Group Plc



Oilfield services company, Expro International, will be moving its UK head office from Reading Bridge House to Stonemartin's Davidson House in Forbury Square, Reading. Stonemartin has signed a 10-year lease agreement with Expro at the rate of £24.00 per sq ft, with a view to move its 70 staff into the new 10,940 sq ft office in early 2007.

Davidson House totals 112,000 sq ft office and is operated by Stonemartin as part of its managed and serviced office portfolio. The deal to Expro sits outside of this arrangement, following the freeholders decision to take back a standing lease commitment from Asset Co in July 2006 and re-let that space. Commenting on the deal Tom Fletcher, Surveyor at LSH, said "Davidson House is attracting some impressive corporate interest, with an additional 11,435 sq ft first floor accommodation available to let, this provides a fine opportunity for a major occupier to acquire striking office premises in a high profile location."
